

Student Research Grant

If you're in school or further/higher education and you intend to carry out a project or piece of research that relates to the cultural, built or natural heritage of the North Isles of Orkney then you could be eligible to apply for up to £500 of funding from the North Isles Landscape Partnership Scheme (NILPS). Funding is aimed towards the costs associated with carrying out your research such as travel, research materials or equipment.

The North Isles Landscape Partnership Scheme is a £4.5 million scheme that will deliver a range of projects across the North Isles over a 5 year period. The aim of the scheme is to preserve, enhance and promote the North Isles natural, built and cultural heritage through providing funding for a range of physical improvements, conservation and landscape projects, training, heritage interpretation and educational projects.

Applications for funding will be considered on a case by case basis. You must submit a completed application form and have a formal decision from the NILPS team before you commit to costs involved.

Further guidance on claiming the grant will be provided if your application is successful.

Once your project is complete you must submit a copy of your research to the NILPS team.
